# **Suggestions For The Indie Film Maker - Making A Green Screen Hollywood Studio**

You just need a couple of hours, paint, papers, fresh paint rollers, and a few tape in making a customized screen. Here are some basic steps on the way to create a green screen. Get a practical place. The best location for a green chroma key screen is a room having a large wall structure. The area also needs to be spacious. Ask friends and family if they'd like to spare their shed. This could function as the temporary studio. As soon as the perfect location is found, buy the necessary materials.

Go shopping for fresh paint and other necessities. When searching for paint, decide on the suitable hue of green. It shouldn't be too light or too dark. Additionally make sure that the color is the flat type. It is because glossy fresh paint might reflect light and result in unsightly blemishes on the film. Right after finalizing the color, purchase additional painting products. Purchase some paint rollers, paint trays, and artwork adhesives. Also get a hold of old papers. This may function as protective linings to areas of the facility which shouldn't be colored green. Immediately after collecting all the essential things, proceed to generating the Do it yourself green screen Hollywood.

Establish boundaries. Line the surface of the floor near the intended chroma key space with paper. Ideally, the lining needs to be three tiers thick. This would be enough to prevent the floor from any color splatters. Including more pieces of paper is recommended. Right after placing old newspapers all over the workshop, safeguard them with tape. This is so that the newspapers won't shift as the work is getting done. Also, line the edges you would like to paint with tape. The tape needs to be put as a protective edge for the rest of the wall that shouldn't be colored green. Once this is accomplished, begin painting.

Make some art for art. Paint the wall by using a roller brush. The strokes needs to be even, so that the colour and surface will be consistent. Keep in mind that the screen is going to be utilized to create cinematic gems, so it is important to apply paint appropriately. After painting the entire area, wait for the paint to dry before taking off the tape and newspaper linings. After the pain has dried up and all the linings are removed, the screen can now be used. With affordable supplies, anyone may use green screen Hollywood technology to produce movies.
