# Choosing the right Stroller

A reliable restraint system is crucial which secures baby at the shoulders, waist and crotch. Look for a secondary locking mechanism on the frame. This ensures that the stroller cannot fold while in use. To prevent rolling, check for reliable, rear-wheel brakes.

Make sure that the frame must be topple-resistant, in the unfold and fold position. You should be able to evaluate accessibility to get baby in and out. Do not consider models with unfinished edges. For easy access to baby some models do offer bars that open easily. A fantastic choice would be lightweight strollers because they are both light and sturdy. To fold and unfold the stroller easily should be another key feature. Think about folding a stroller with one hand while baby is in the other. To fasten and unfasten the harness quickly should be a key point. Stroller weight should be considered since it is tedious to maneuver heavyweight strollers.

The stroller needs will change based on the number of children. Should look for dual, swivel front wheels and one-handed steering. Should also consider how easy is it to adjust the stroller back or activate the brakes. Smooth operating mechanisms, adjustable handles and padded ergonomic handles are great features for strollers.

Always consider the weight of the stroller. You might not think that you need to worry about the weight of something with wheels. But you will have to deal with it when you fold it and store it or have to drag it through an airport folded. This isn't so much of a concern for those who don't ever fold their stroller. Also make sure that, when folded, the stroller will fit in the trunk of your car.

We need to consider how easily does the stroller fold down and how small does it get. This is useful when transporting your stroller to and from places like the mall, park or airport, or even for a quick trip to friend's house. For those who store the stroller in the closet or trunk this is also important to be sure it doesn't take up too much space.
