Rain water is also far more pure than tap water with an average of only 004 parts per million impurities, compare that to London tap water with nearly 400 parts per million of impurities. For window cleaners using the water fed pole method the use of rain water is not only better for the environment but it also means that the purification process is made easier and any filters will last far far longer.

Not only does using recycled rainwater provide window cleaners with a free essential cleaning product (how many things are free these days?) it also assists with keeping city supplies more sustainable, by being eco friendly.

It is both simple and cheap to collect and store rainwater and a typical half inch rainfall can fill a number of 50 to 80 gallon rain butts. If you think that the roof of a house measuring 2 000 square foot, can collect approximately 1 000 gallon of water, think how many 50 gallon rain butts can be filled.

Enough to keep every London window cleaner happily working for a very long time without even touching city supplies!

Collecting water is not hard work with a rain butt, simply position it correctly and it fills itself every time it rains, and can also be stored. Your roof is giant funnel which dispenses free water; you just collect it for use.
