These home security systems do not use any wires at all and rely on a control center that sends wireless signals to the alarms themselves at pretty impressive distances. This also allows more breathing room for planning as the control panel can be placed in any accessible area followed by the alarms being placed all around the control panel. It may be possible for the alarm to be out of range, but that can easily be determined through trial and error and changing the location of an alarm isn't very time consuming.

It is also easy to change the setup and may not even involve moving the control panel. If a new room is added for instance, an additional alarm may be required as long as it can communicate with the panel.

Even though wireless home security systems tend to cost a little bit more than the wired systems, you can still end up saving some money, providing you're willing to do a little bit of research online, in that there are several manufacturers now competing with the manufacturers of wired systems.
