# **What Is Ebook Reader And How To Chose Ereader Device? Ebook Reader Prices.**

E-reader is the compact personal gadget for reading ebooks. Like a personal computer it consists of the hardware components as e-ink display, processor, flash memory and the software used to read electronic books. Ebooks are formatted texts which may be written in various languages, encoding and formats. The best reading device is that one which supports those ebooks which you want to read!

The main difference between new generation electronic paper displays and usual TFT or LCD screens widely used in compact pc, mobile phones and laptops is the absence of any backlight. In difference to E-ink, TFT and LCD displays are back lighted with compact fluorescent lamps, using mercury gas for lighting or LED lights inside. The backlit is the main reason for our eyes to get tired after long reading from computer screens.

E-ink electronic paper displays provide reader with original ink on real paper feeling. E-paper use demands direct lighting same as usual book reading. No light is emitted by them! Thus our eyes are kept safe. Other advantage of the new technology is significantly lower energy consumption. They can work many times longer than old fashioned readers or other gadgets with TFT (LCD) screens used for reading. One full battery charge of e-ink eBook reader is usually sufficient to read thousands of pages for weeks because electricity is used only for pages turning.

The most spread brands of ereaders with electronic paper e-ink displays available in U.S. are Kindle, Sony, Hanvon ( Azbuka ), Onyx Boox ( also marketed as BeBook Neo ), Booken, Irex, Hanlin, Pocketbook ( Neutronix), Nook. Most of these e-readers have unique features useful for one people and useless for others. With Kindle 3G wireless reader you are able to purchase and download English ebooks from Amazon. Sony ebook readers support Sony ebook reader store format and also epub and pdf. The same does Nook with Barnes & Nobles book store. Onyx Boox and Hanvon N516, N518 and N526 do not support Amazon or Sony formats but they support wide range of universal ebook formats inclusive free and open formats and some DRM. These e-Book readers are most suitable for those who prefer to be able to download ebooks from any sources and in various languages and codings.

We browsed Amazon and dealers website to combine the best prices for ereaders in the U.S. market in April 2010:

5-inch ereaders: The largest e-book reader manufacturer in the world, Hanvon offers three e-book reading devices models in this size. More than anyone else. Hanvon N516 priced at \$189 is the best cheap e-ink ereader. Same design but more featured Hanvon N518 with stylus operated sensor screen and hand writing recognition is offered at \$239, Hanvon N526 with different design and qwesad keyboard at \$259. All Hanvon ereaders prices usually include USB cord, 2GB or 4GB SD card and leather protective case. Pocketbook 360 bundle with accessories is priced at \$259. It has a good design and firmware but it is rather expensive for the device without touch screen. Sony PRS-300 is a plain model without many functions. It also has a greyish screen by many reviews. Sony PRS-300 is sold cheaper at Amazon than at Sony Style online store. The best price for Sony PRS-300 starts there at \$168 without accessories and at \$219 with all accessories. Booken Cybook Opus is priced at \$194. Hanlin ( Astak EZ ) at \$199.

6 inch e-readers: famous Onyx Boox 60 with sensor screen hand writing and wireless access through WiFi and web browser with a new price as \$295 with all accessories worth \$40 seems to be the best choice now, BeBook Neo - rebranded Onyx Boox 60 is offered at \$299 without accessories, Sony PRS-600 with sensor screen is better to buy at Amazon where it is cheaper than in Sony Style. The best ereader price without accessories is \$263 and \$329 with all of them. Amazon Kindle 2 without accessories is sold at \$259, Nook bare device - \$259-278 ( cheaper to buy from Barnes directly ), Viewsonic - \$217, same pocketbook 301 - \$275 without accessories. 6" Astak EZ reader without options is \$239. Last 3 models seem to be overpriced for plain ereaders without wireless function and hand writing. Emerging Pocketbook 302 with WiFi and touch screen is \$339.

Large screen models are presented by Kindle DX \$489 for 9.7 inch ereader, 8,1 inch Irex DR 800 at \$399 and the same price 7 inch Sony Reader Edition. Emerging Plastic Logic QUO begins from \$649.
