Embedding SEO within your sales copy plays a vital role in how your site ranks in the search engines. The main focus of search engine copywriting is writing web content that focuses on your keywords; ensuring proper research and analysis have been put into the selection of keywords so they apply closely to your product or service. Impacting your placement, this is critical in regards to not employing unspecific target keywords. You can use your chosen keywords in appropriate places such as headline or the title of your article. Most readers will decide what they wish to read by scanning the headline only, so yours should grab their attention right away. Search engines look for opening lines to find a content's summary, so you should also utilize these keywords in the beginning of the main paragraphs of the content.

Your choice of keywords is "key" in the ultimate success of the SEO copy you compose. Careful consideration needs to be given to which combination of phrases and keywords yields the best possible results for your site. First, your keywords must be targeted (we'll talk about this in a minute). Secondly, don't just place them at the beginning of your content; sprinkle them throughout the body of the article. Your goal is to concentrate on two or three main keywords which you will use throughout our copy. You also need to keep track of how often those keywords and phrases are used within your copy. The consensus among Internet marketers is that about 3% of the total words in your copy should be your targeted keywords. However, this is a somewhat informal indication so you shouldn't worry if you stray from it a little bit. Just keep in mind that your copy is not just for the search engines, but it's also going to be read by people - it has to sell. If you are forcing phrases into places that make little sense for them your copy will not make sense and lose value. One approach is to write your copy first so that it flows; then add your keywords where they best fit in. If you don't want to sit there and count your keywords, there are tools available for free use online that can check your keyword density for you.

A proper copyright is every bit as important as how you "aim" your content at the big search engines. Copy that fails to keep your visitors on your site won't bring you any new sales, no matter how great your keywords may be. In fact, the strength and superiority of the copy is the single most pertinent aspect of this entire online marketing procedure. The content should flow smoothly from the title, be easily readable and keep the reader's interest. Content must be focused toward the person who will read it to keep their interest; good optimization for Google and other search engines is also a goal but should not be your main focus when writing. That function of search engines is not only to bring relevant results to searchers, but also the highest quality of the bunch. This is why spamming your pages full of your keywords won't work; the search engines will only ignore your website.

A final word of advice is to make sure you include your major keywords in the first paragraph of your web content; search engines often don't go very deep into your copy, so having them early on is critical. Make sure that any links you have to pages deeper within your site are text-based as many engines will not read or follow image-based links.
