- Additionally, buyers often become confused on eBay because they have so many items listed and so many users. A notepad or spreadsheet can greatly minimize the confusion that can result from looking at so many opportunities. Double check the electronic standards of any electronic equipment you are considering buying online. If it was engineered in a different country, it may not work in your country. This typically occurs when products are sold from around the world at these auction sites.

- Auction sites in other countries most often have local taxes you'll have to pay for electronic products. Import duty might be applied on particular products and it could end up with the price increasing.

- A variety of accessories are made by a 3rd party. You should verify that the accessories you want to buy come from the original manufacturer and not a 3rd party.

- When you look for electronic equipment online, be sure to double check the status of the equipment you are considering. Remember that you aren't able to actually examine the product. Auction sites often list used merchandise; these are often priced low and look quite good. Watch out for this if you are looking for a new product. Also, keep an eye out for online counterfeiters.

- Check the seller's profile and merchant's rating to get an idea of how honest they are in dealing authentic items. Know the shipping time. Usually this can be as much as 4 weeks. You need to look at other online auctions sites, if your needs are immediate.
