One of the networks that still use the 12 month contract for the iphone is Tesco mobile, but it depends if you would be willing to pay a little bit extra for the handset.

Depending on the amount of time you have chosen to stay with your network contract for the iphone, it is more likely that an updated version of the iphone has been released. If you chose the 12 month package then you would be able to receive the newer version. However if you have chosen the 18 month contract it could be possible to upgrade your iphone for a little cash amount. Although if you are tied in to a 24 month package there would be no chance to upgrade your iphone for a large period of time without paying a rather big amount of money.

One last thing, do you really need a contract? Most pay as you go network deals are brilliant they can offer up to the same amount of talk time and texts as a contract for cheaper. Yes you have the cost of the iphone but for the amount of time you are tied to a contract you would be paying the amount of the iphone and possibly more. Also you won't have to worry about running over your talk time or text limit.
