What Are Home Security Alarm Systems Of Today

There are many home security alarm systems available to the security minded, in a wide variety ranging from simple to sophisticated. These systems can protect the person or the person's whole environment. They offer protection from outside intrusion, but also can be valuable for everyday living and help prevent genuine accidents.

The systems are fun to explore, starting with a simple keypad lock on the door (no more hunting for keys) or a pepper gun spray to carry on evening walks. Most of us are familiar with the boxes in Manhattan apartments, whereby a resident can screen callers before 'buzzing' them in to the street entrance. We have seen the alarms on the rear doors of stores and antique malls, to have an exit unlocked for fire safety but unavailable for patrons, who must leave by the front entrance, in sight of store staff.

Homes can have everything from keypad deadbolts to voice activated locks, from sensors so you can safely open a door on a sunny day to those which alert you to people in the driveway. The swimming pool can be surrounded with sensors to keep children and pets safe, and to alert those inside to unauthorized activity outside.

Perimeter fences can be equipped with electronic gates with keypads, so only those with the code can enter unless they first buzz the house for permission. Garages are secured with coded electronic locks as well, and opened and closed remotely with key chain or car mounted switches. The garage doors can be programmed to close automatically after a set period of time.

One door or every door and window in the house may be secured with hardwired alarms, motion detectors, wireless sensors, audio devices that react to sound, and shock detectors that will sound off at the vibrations of breaking glass, for instance. Surveillance cameras can be prominent or completely hidden, and motion detectors come with lights and sound, if desired.

Fire alarms have been around for years, but now the wise homeowner can have freeze detectors, that can alert people to the danger of extreme cold and they can protect their pipes before costly damage is done throughout the house. Alarms can sense leaks as well, and be programmed with numbers to call in the emergency.

Family security can give parents peace of mind, with video and audio nursery monitors, cameras that can show play rooms and outside play areas, and sensors that monitor every door and window, from the front to the patio sliding doors and the basement windows. Children can carry a 'tracker', so Mom and Dad know where they are. The elderly can wear a device with a panic button to press if they cannot get to the phone, or remote control of a speaker phone to call for help.

There are sophisticated systems for computer security that range from a simple password to a retinal scan. Garages, tool sheds, boats and boathouses, and vacation houses need no longer be vulnerable to intrusion when the owner is away. Security is available for every person and every possession, from the safe in the den to the perimeter of an estate. State and local laws regulate which system will be the best choice for that area.
