Before it was a choice of lithographic print which was expensive and meant you had to have large volume to make it viable financially.

At last artist could have limited editions print runs and see their works printed onto canvas at a fraction of the cost and also in small numbers. The main difference between printing artist's originals onto canvas and photos on canvas is the degree of experience and expertise. The process is basically the same but with artwork the printer needs to have a much higher degree of experience and understanding of colour. Particularly as artists are far more trained in spotting colour variation and tend to be more precise in their requirements; hence why fine art printers still remain a small group of experienced and specialist companies.

Digital printing has opened the doors to so many possibilities and one of the most popular is printing photos onto canvas. Whether that is one's wedding photos, baby photos, holiday photos, portrait photos or professional photography. The canvas prints come in all shapes and sizes.

Helpful Tips for Best Results: The main things to watch out for when printing your photos onto canvas online are:

1. Make sure your photo is at least 300pi and your camera is set at the highest resolution setting. Higher pixels mean better quality on the whole so make sure your photos are high resolution and at least 4mb.
2. Make sure your file sure jpeg or something similar compatible with the online service you use.
3. Make sure if you have a square photo that you choose a square size canvas print. If you have a landscape photo (rectangle) then you choose a landscape or rectangle size canvas print. This is very important. A square photo can be stretched onto a 12x24 size canvas print but it will look very odd. Check carefully your photos and the sizes you choose. Think about the shape you are choosing and what your photo is before you order or click the wrong size.
4. Also remember as you enlarge a photo it will have to be wrapped around the edge of the frame. So if you have photos with people or things close to the edge of the image, either choose an option suitable or remember it will be wrapped over.
