#### Cloudy/Overcast

If you think fairly assured it isn't likely to rain, opt for a sunny color or happy style. Photographers and film directors basically like cloudy and overcast climate because the lighting is more complementing for all skin shades and kinds. You should take advantage on this. #### Rainy

I can't stress this more than enough: if rain is incorporated in the weather forecast on the nights your event, wear black. #### Hot & Humid

#### Warm & Dry

If it is hot and dry, you may use sequins and heavily adorned gowns. Something that shines just like the desert sun will light up an area. Shoulders, legs, and backs can and should be bare. Sherri Hill cocktail dresses are sequin rock stars. Try to find the #226 in silver, bronze, or gold.

#### Windy

Surprisingly, I suggest wearing a short dress when it's windy. It will however be tight fitting.

A lengthy dress will cloak you in too much moveable fabric. You will end up having difficulties to walk, stumbling around yourself. While a short, moving dress might blow up and...uh oh.

In a collection of Tony Bowls cocktail dresses, I selected a turquoise hip hugger (#TS21044). It's an asymmetrical 3/4-inch sleeve for added warmth.

#### Cold But Clear

Conceal whenever possible. Go with earthy and velvety hues. I saved a page from a Jasz cocktail dresses catalog having a mile long, eggplant dazzler (#4067). I additionally discovered one example from Precious Formals cocktail dresses. An Elizabethan gown in purple passion (#P44132).

Conceal much more! And trust me when I state, forget about anything black. If you have ever been caught in the snow putting on something black, you know what I mean. Dried out snow on dark clothing can evaporate up into a dirty, salty mess.

Even though you are at it, ex out everything white. To begin with, if it is freezing out, it is usually post-Labor Day and you know much better than that. If you find some Terani cocktail dresses, look for style #95013P. It's ice blue and you will feel swaddled in eons of fabric.
