Spam is not automatically deleted but mostly kept in a separate folder to your inbox. The mistake that protection programs make is that they sometimes take genuine emails to the spam folder.

Email categorized as spam can be transferred from the spam folder to the inbox easily when found and normally future mail from the same source will be transferred to the inbox.

An alternative is to use email-spamming programs which you can use to manually check if the mail is genuine or a spam. Once installed all it requires is for you to use it to scan individual emails.
