# **Advantages Of Online Vs. Traditional Classroom Education**

### Personalized Attention

At the other end of the scale, if a student progresses through the work quickly, they can complete their studies in less time and then move on to study additional assignments or more advanced work.

For children there can be social pressures. Online learning simply provides a comfortable environment in which students can learn free of these pressures. It focuses solely on providing people with a quality education.
