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Have You Considered Flight Training

Each year a large number of Americans consider taking up the process of flight training. Unfortunately, only a small fraction actually do so. Why? For the vast majority, it's because of the extremely expense of flight training. From the ground to a fully licensed commercial pilot, the price can soar well beyond \$50,000. A hobbyist buying basic Private Pilot's License (PPL) will normally expect to pay more than \$5,000. That's quite a sour pill to swallow for anyone, from hobbyists to career oriented individuals.

Flight training is basically just like fifty years ago. Actually, the majority of the planes a prospective pilot would train in are Cessna 150's or 172's from the 1960s! These relics will charge you anywhere from \$100-200 an hour or so to fly dual pilot by having an instructor. This really is by far the most expensive part of flight training.

Fortunately, technology has come a long means by the last half a century. Now you can do the ground schooling like a self study package from various on the internet and distance outfits. This will permit you to spend the minimum amount of time within an actual flight school paying their exorbitant rates, and can allow you to learn at your own pace-fast or slow.

If you're well studied in advance it is possible to pass both your written as well as your flight Private Pilot's License (PPL) exams inside a much shorter time period. This can reduce your flight training and can eliminate your requirement for a traditional ground school entirely. There is absolutely no requirement from the FAA to go to a traditional ground school. FAA Advisory Circular (AC) No: 61-65D states:

COMPLETION OF GROUND TRAINING Or perhaps a HOME STUDY CURRICULUM. Ground training courses to prepare for that aeronautical knowledge test may be provided by pilot schools, colleges, aviation organizations, and individual flight or ground instructors.

Obviously you cannot actually learn to physically fly a plane online. You will have to attend a flying school to actually fly a plane. Appropriate simulator environments are a long distance from consumer use. The main objectives from the self study kits are two fold: One, you can write your PPL exams without stepping foot into ground school. Two, you may be ready to fly to help you pass the expensive dual pilot lessons in the absolute minimum period of time. It's probable that the self study kit can reduce your pricey flying time enough in order to save you thousands of dollars.

In short, you should you should consider an online or distance education. They start at around the \$35 mark for a full self study package.
