Dont get ripped off with designer fakes

With many fashion deals on the net and in the stores that appear too fantastic to be true how does one identify the real deals from the knockoffs? It's good to always be careful the place you shop as a trustworthy store will not gamble their standing with fraudulent products. Also please remember many top designers will only provide their products to recognised retailers and internet-based stores. They will not ever sell to flea marketplaces or road traders regardless of how desperate they are!
