Virtual hosting will involve sharing of hardware but the computer is configured in a way that allocates a portion of resources exclusively to your website. Since your website gets exclusive allocation it is possible to guaranteed speeds and storage space. Constant capacity is one of the main advantages this option has over shared hosting. Security is another area where you will not have concerns beyond your own website.

Security in virtual hosting is an individual concern unlike shared hosting where it is a shared concern. If another website on the machine is compromised there is very little chance of your website coming under attack. Another big plus for virtual hosting is having root access which means you have greater control of your website.

There clearly are more benefits in virtual hosting as compared to shared hosting. In some circumstances your business web hosting may not require much. Such situations allow for shared hosting though you need to make sure you work with a reliable provider. With growth you can later move to virtual hosting and when your business demands greater capacity and over you could then move on to a managed dedicated server host.
