Finding A Good Quality Cell Phone Battery

You will be surprised at how cell phones have become an integral part of your life and that you feel lost without your cell phone. You are using your cell phone not only for calls but to check your messages, for GPRS and many more things. No wonder you cannot do without your cell phone even for a short while.

When you use your cell phone constantly the first thing that wears out is the battery. In a few months time you will find that the battery has gone dead and you need to replace it with a new one. The question is where will you buy from? Will you buy it online or from the cheapest price shop? Most of us make the mistake of going in for cheap stuff without checking to see if the batteries are really from a good company or of good quality.

Go through these simple few points and make a note so that when you do go to buy the battery you know what to look for.

The best thing for you to do is to make a note of the model and the specifications of your existing battery and ask for a same or similar replacement.

If you buy an original OEM battery from the company's show room you will find an indicator built into the battery. Whereas when you buy from the aftermarket, this indicator may not be present which means the battery can get overheated without you noticing and leak into the gadget.

You should also know that the OEM Batteries sold through the company showrooms come with warranty. Those sold through the after market do not carry warranty and it is quite likely that you might end up buying more number of batteries from the aftermarket if the life is not up to the mark.

The aftermarket batteries are much cheaper than the OEM batteries and accordingly if the performance is not guaranteed, you cannot do anything about it.

Finally the decision is yours to make whether you wish to go and pay a price for an original battery or a cheaper battery from the spares market. It is essentially a tradeoff between price and performance. The other important factor that you need to consider is also the value of the handset that you are using. If it is an expensive model can you take chances?
