# **The Things You Need to Learn About NCR Pads**

NCR stands for No Carbon Required. [NCR pads](#) are paper treated with a special type of coating. It could be glued in sets of two or more papers, then the papers will react to the pressure of a pen or pencil or other writing device.

Whatever you write on the first paper of the NCR pad will be copied on to the paper under that one, and so on. So instead of writing the information twice, you are able to fill it in once and then give the second or third copy to someone else. It makes it simpler and also ensures that all parties have the exact same info on their paper.

It is frequently utilized for writing cheques, filling out forms, signing contracts along with other similar things. With NCR pads you do not need carbon paper which is usually utilized to achieve the exact same effects.

When the sheets of paper have all been printed they are added together into groups of 50. So each NCR pad will have 50 sheets of NCR paper. They are usually glued on the short edges at the top of the paper but you are able to get them glued along the long end on the side or wherever you'd rather have.

All of the NCR pads have firm back boards, usually produced out of cardboard or other sturdy paper to keep the pad in great shape. They could also be fitted with extra hinges or writing shields, in the event you want.

NCR pads have paper that comes in five different colors. That's white, yellow, blue, green or pink. You'll have the ability to have any or all of these various colors, in whatever order you like. Usually for the exact same price you can also get your company name or logo printed in ink on the bottom or top of the NCR pads and papers.

You can also get the papers numbered in the event you believe you'll need that, the papers can also be drilled having a couple of small holes so you can add them to a ring binder if necessary. All of this may usually be provided in the same price or for a little additional fee.

Before you order the NCR pads check how many you actually will need. This may appear obvious, but if you get too few you'll have to create another order which will cost you more money in the end. Also make sure you find out what size of NCR pads you'll be wanting.

The size will make a difference in just how much it costs. There's no need to get huge NCR pads if littler ones would do just as well. Check if you can get printed envelopes done by the same business so you can save money by having everything done at one time.

You should also consult with one of the customer support workers. You can explain to them what you'll need NCR pads for, and then see what they would advise. They have more expertise than you so it might be worth hearing their advise on NCR pads.
