These have been accepted by woman of different regions as well, and you will find lady putting on them even in western nations where these are known as kaftans. These are towards demand and are very comfortable as well.

How is it different from a Jilbab?

However an Abaya is somewhat similar to a Jilbab, they have their differences as well. An abaya (common Muslim wear for women, specifically for Middle Easter khaleeji female) is similar to a jilbab as both of them cover the whole shape completely. The difference lies into their sleeves. The sleeves of a jilbab are stitched to the main body for the cloak, whereas an abaya is a single piece of cloak. Its cut itself includes the sleeves without stitching it. These have impressive necklines, sleeves and bases with heavy embroideries.

Their design

These days this garment has been stylized in a few ways by quite a few designers. Certain for the standard design are:

- * They are usually produced of light materials, like lexis crepe and satin.
- * They might be open front throughout their entire length or they might be completely closed.
- * Most of them come in funky and intricate models varying form geometric styles to floral ones.
- * They might as well be designed with heavy embroidery in gold and silver.
- * Several of these are as well styled with beads, sequins, multi coloured crystals, and Swarovski gems (for the high end designer ones).
