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If you've always wanted to create a professional podcast but knew that you lacked somewhere, then the following article will help you immensely in getting you the right start ...

Try to be Natural: Trying to be too official or dodgy in your approach will make you look artificial - it will simply show up, and your listeners will notice that you're trying to put up a show. Instead of this, try to be as natural as you can so that you don't have to deal with uncomfortable situation with your listeners. However if you behave in a too laid-back or lazy manner, this can also create a bad impression. Being focused on just being yourself and moving with the flow is what we mean by being natural. You really don't have to put too much work into this because each little step that you take to keep your podcast natural will have benefits. Besides this, don't read your podcast out of a script that you wrote and end up sounding like robotic. Your listeners will be happier with you if you are just natural in your approach in your podcast.

Good Guest Interviews: most of the talking. This is the only way you're going to get your listeners to enjoy your podcast because if someone's listening to your interview then they want to see what the guest has to say in response to your questions. Try to make your questions short and fast but avoid close ended ones. Regardless of the kind of topic you are covering in the interview, allow your guest to handle the "value-giving" portion and it will make your listeners happy. While it is ok if you have the urge to talk in between or offer your own input during your podcast, be careful that you don't do it at the expense of the value you are trying derive from your guest.

Inject Some Humor: A podcast that is humorous and lighthearted and still manages to convey information without being boring is one that will catch listeners attention. You are probably aware that it is just not the quality of your content that is important here, but also how you convey it through your podcast. Including some humor now and again won't harm you, and may actually make your podcast fun for your listeners. Not only that, if you aren't having a good time when you make the podcast, it will show and that obviously is not a good thing. While you want your listener to feel that you know your subject, you don't want them to think you are compulsive. You will reel them in if your podcast offers your listeners a good feeling as well as a dose of the right kind of humor.
