Another purpose of servers is that they provide data backup and storage. In addition they serve to provide email and internet access--chances are, you've got already been using servers before when surfing the internet and accessing your own email. The servers for internet hosting providers aren't all that different; they merely hold more information.

So, why do you need web hosting for your website? The short solution is that without it, no one aside from you will be able to see your website. You will need web hosting in order for your website to be live; in other words, web hosting allows the world to get access to your site. There are other services that are provided by web hosting providers, however.

Through a web hosting provider, you will be able to register a site name--this is the address of your website, including mywebsite.com. You will also be able to have an email address at your domain name whereby people (customers and clients, perhaps?) can contact you. Your email may be something like myname@mywebsite.org. A web host also enables you to back up your data online, manage the appearance of your site, and much more.
