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Ensuring you have all of the critical items that you need to create a feature film can be extremely complicated. Ensuring that everything is in concert with to create the perfect film that you will be envisioning is never easy, but spending some time to ensure that everything is proper before you begin recording your film is vital. Without good sound, you are likely to lose a large number of people who would make up your potential audience. This will often cause a great film to turn out largely ignored and a filmmaker extremely frustrated.

Your first piece of equipment is going to be a microphone. This is something that should be looked at far well before actually shooting any of the scenes so that you can be certain you are getting the best sound possible. Each microphone could have a different range that it is most effective. Your key to having good sound from them are all knowing the proper range for the microphone that you are using. If you want a microphone that records close-up, then you need to ensure you have proper placement, without getting so close that you're interrupting the filming in the scene. A microphone dropping in to the scene during recording can ruin footage and make additional headaches in the future.

Microphone cables will be your second critical component. This has to be properly installed or you will discover that after spending a day shooting a scene that you just love, you have no sound to do business with. Nothing is worse than finding out you've got wasted an entire day filming as the microphone cables were not properly connected. A period of time check is essential to ensure that they are connected. Aside from just ensuring the cables are connected, you'll want to ensure you pick up cables which are a good quality. Poor quality cables could cause problems when you are trying to record the sound which enable it to add interference into the recording. Being very careful to avoid interference as well as ensure proper connection will go a long way towards ensuring that sound is correctly recorded.

A final step looks at the sound software that you have. Using good quality sound editing software you can create huge changes to the recording because you will have the flexibility to easily customize the order of speech and sounds. It's also possible to work to adjust the sound levels for the scene to adjust for ambient noises too. You might discover that while you were recording there is an annoying siren in the background that's distracting from the scene, having additional ambient sound footage you'd be able to replace the siren, that can assist you to save the footage entirely.

As you have seen, each of these three components is critical to create the overall feeling for the movie. A feature film which includes poor sound will likely lose the eye of the audience very quickly. Taking the time to really pull together the right sound equipment is a great step towards ensuring the achievements of your movie. Taking pride in the sound will show as people are viewing your movie, and offers you a great opportunity to play with different sound scenarios to find out what really works best for the average person feature film that you are creating. Knowing how to make the changes and produce the quality results will be a key benefit that will you well for all feature films you create.
